CONSENSUS RULES

It is understood that the contract for the funding of the Partnership has specific deliverables and deadlines that must be met. While the desire is for the Partnership members to achieve maximum consensus on items, due to time constraints, it may be necessary for the Project Manager of the Partnership to make decisions without maximum consensus. The following guidelines will be used to gain maximum input and consensus on items coming before the Partnership members.

- CONSENSUS IS SHOWN AS FOLLOWS:
 - 5 MEANS WHOLEHEARTED SUPPORT
 - 4 MEANS SUPPORT
 - 3 MEANS NEUTRAL BUT WILL SUPPORT FULLY TO OUTSIDE WORLD
 - 2 MEANS YOU STILL HAVE QUESTIONS YOU NEED TO ASK
 - 1 INDICATES CONCERN

- ALL PARTNERSHIP MEMBERS TAKE PART IN CONSENSUS RANKING.

- GAINING MAXIMUM CONSENSUS WILL BE INDICATED IF A MAJORITY OF THE PARTNERSHIP MEMBERS PRESENT AT THE MEETING RANK AN ITEM "3" OR BETTER.
